

IFFCO opens new bio-fertiliser plant in Paradip

A bio-fertiliser plant, the 8th Evaporator in Phosphoric Acid Plant and revamping of Sulphur Silo were inaugurated by Mr U S Awasthi, the CEO and managing director of Indian Farmers Fertiliser Coop. Ltd. (IFFCO) here today in the presence of farmers and other senior officers of IFFCO.

Mr Awasthi has addressed the large gathering of farmers and explained to them about the utilisation of Bio-fertiliser. He said IFFCO supplies 38 per cent of the complex fertiliser requirement of the country. The high level
