Sub: Celebration of WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY - 2016

World Environment Day (WED) is the United Nations' most important day for encouraging worldwide awareness and action, for the protection of our environment. World Environment day is commemorated on 5th June every year. Each WED is organized around a theme that focuses attention on a particularly pressing environmental concern. WED 2016 is themed on the illegal trade in wildlife under the slogan 'Go Wild for Life'.

THE MEANING OF THE THEME IS

ZERO TOLERANCE FOR THE ILLEGAL WILDLIFE TRADE

The booming illegal trade in wildlife products is eroding Earth's precious biodiversity, robbing us of our natural heritage and pushing whole species towards extinction.

Like previous years, this year also "World Environment Day" will be celebrated at our Unit as per the following program.

1. Tree Plantation

Tree Plantation Program shall be arranged by **Horticulture Section** at 9.00 AM on 5.6.2016 in IFFCO Premises to show our commitment towards protection of Environment.

2. Competitions for dependent children

i. Painting competition for children of classes I, II & III

Painting competition for dependent children (Standard I to III) shall be organized on 3.6.2016. Theme of the painting competition shall be "**Our Environment**".

ii. Painting competition for children of classes IV, V & VI

Painting competition for dependent children (Standard IV to VI) shall be organized on 3.6.2016. Theme of the painting competition shall be "**Environment Protection Measures**".

(A brief explanation of the Theme: The painting should showcase various pollution control measures by which we can control water pollution, control air pollution, conserve soil, make the planet cooler etc)

iii. Painting competition for children of classes VII, VIII & IX

Painting competition for dependent children (Standard VII to IX) shall be organized on 3.6.2016. Theme of the painting competition shall be "**Conservation of Earth**".
(A brief explanation of the Theme: The painting should showcase various ways in which we can conserve different earthly resources like water, soil, minerals, flora, fauna, atmosphere etc)

iv. Essay Competition for children of classes X, XI & XII

Essay competition for dependant school children (Standard X to XII) shall be organized on 3.6.2016.

Topic – "**Are humans responsible for Climate Change?**" / **क्या इंसान जलवायु परिवर्तन के लिए जिम्मेदार है?/ଜଳବାୟୁ ପରିବର୍ତ୍ତନ ପାଇଁ ମନୁଷ୍ୟ ଦାୟୀ ଅଟେ କି?**

Essay can be written either in English, Hindi or Odia languages.

Best three essays irrespective of any language shall be awarded.

Venue of all the competitions for children shall be DAV Public School, Time 9.00AM to 10.30AM on 3.6.2016. For drawing competitions, children will bring their own painting/colouring material. Drawing sheet of size 35cm x 28cm for category 2(i) & 2 (ii) and size 56cm x 28 cm for category 2 (iii) shall only be provided.

3. Quiz Competition for Employees

Written Environment Quiz competition for Employees shall be organized on 4.6.2016.

Venue: Old Admin Building, **Time:** 4PM.

Three winners in each category shall be awarded by Unit Head during Independence Day celebration on 15.8.2016.
